## COUNTY OF FREESTONE, TEXAS COUNTY JUDGE DIRECTIVE DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

There is one positive case of the COVID-19 in Freestone County.

The person is quarantined. At this time we have no additional information about the person or area in which they are quarantined..

It is still very important to continue staying at home except for essential services or engaging in essential daily activities while continuing to practice social distancing and continuing to follow personal health hygiene practices, such as washing your hands. These measures are helping slow the spread of the COVID-19.

Also, the CDC has issued an additional recommendation that individuals should wear a cloth face covering whenever they are out in public and cannot maintain 6' social distancing.

The President is also encouraging that only one person per household handle essential functions, such as grocery shopping, whenever possible, to limit exposure for your family and for the workers who are serving you in this critical time.

## These measures are helping slow the spread of the COVID-19.

The next two weeks are important. Freestone County is doing a good job following the Orders and recommendations to help stop the spread and to protect themselves and the other citizens in our County.
