COUNTY OF FREESTONE, TEXAS COUNTY JUDGE DIRECTIVE DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

At this time the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) is currently reporting NO confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Freestone County.

The most important information we have is that staying at home except for essential services, practicing social distancing and continuing to follow personal health hygiene practices, such as washing your hands, is helping slow the spread of the COVID-19.

The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has issued an additional recommendation that individuals should wear a cloth face covering whenever they are out in public and cannot maintain 6' social distancing. You can make your own or use an actual mask, but not a surgical masks or N-95 respirators as those are critical supplies that must continue to be reserved for healthcare workers and other medical first responders.

The President is also encouraging that only one person per household handle essential functions, such as grocery shopping, whenever possible, to limit exposure for your family and for the workers who are serving you in this critical time.

The next two weeks are important. Freestone County is doing a good job following the Orders and recommendations to help stop the spread and to protect themselves and the other citizens in our County.
