

Freestone County
Special Road Use Agreement, Contract and Permit Requirements
for Commissioners Court

- * A representative of the company will need to determine which Commissioner to contact regarding the county road or roads.
- * Special Road Use Agreement, Contract and Permit are in the County Judge's Office.
- * Commissioners have sometimes specified more than one county road on a Special Road Use Agreement (need to check with commissioner in that precinct).
- * Mark location on county road on attached map of Special Road Use Agreement.
- * Surety bonds are set by the commissioner.
- * Surety bonds are sometimes waived.
- * The company executes and returns the original Special Road Use Agreement and original surety bond for Commissioners Court approval.

Special Road Use Agreement, Contract and Permit (Pipeline) – In County Judge's Office

- * A representative of the company will need to determine which Commissioner to contact regarding the county road or roads.
- * Mark location on county road on attached map of Special Road Use Agreement.
- * The company executes and returns the original Special Road Use Agreement for Commissioners Court approval.
- * Generally no surety bond is required.
