ORDER OF EXTENSION FOR DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Freestone has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from severe storms and flooding events that includes heavy rainfall, flash flooding, river flooding, large hail, and hazardous wind gusts throughout the county during unusually heavy rains occurring on April 26, 2024, and continuing thereafter and;

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2024, a Declaration of a Local State of Disaster was declared, signed by the County Judge, and filed with the County Clerk in accordance to Texas Government Code Chapter 418.108.

WHEREAS, a local disaster declaration expires seven (7) days after it is issued, unless commissioners court consents to its continuance or renewal as stated in the Texas Government Code Chapter 418.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Freestone County that the Declaration of a Local State of Disaster be extended for 90 days from today's date, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier. The County Judge has authorization to cancel the order when it is deemed necessary.
